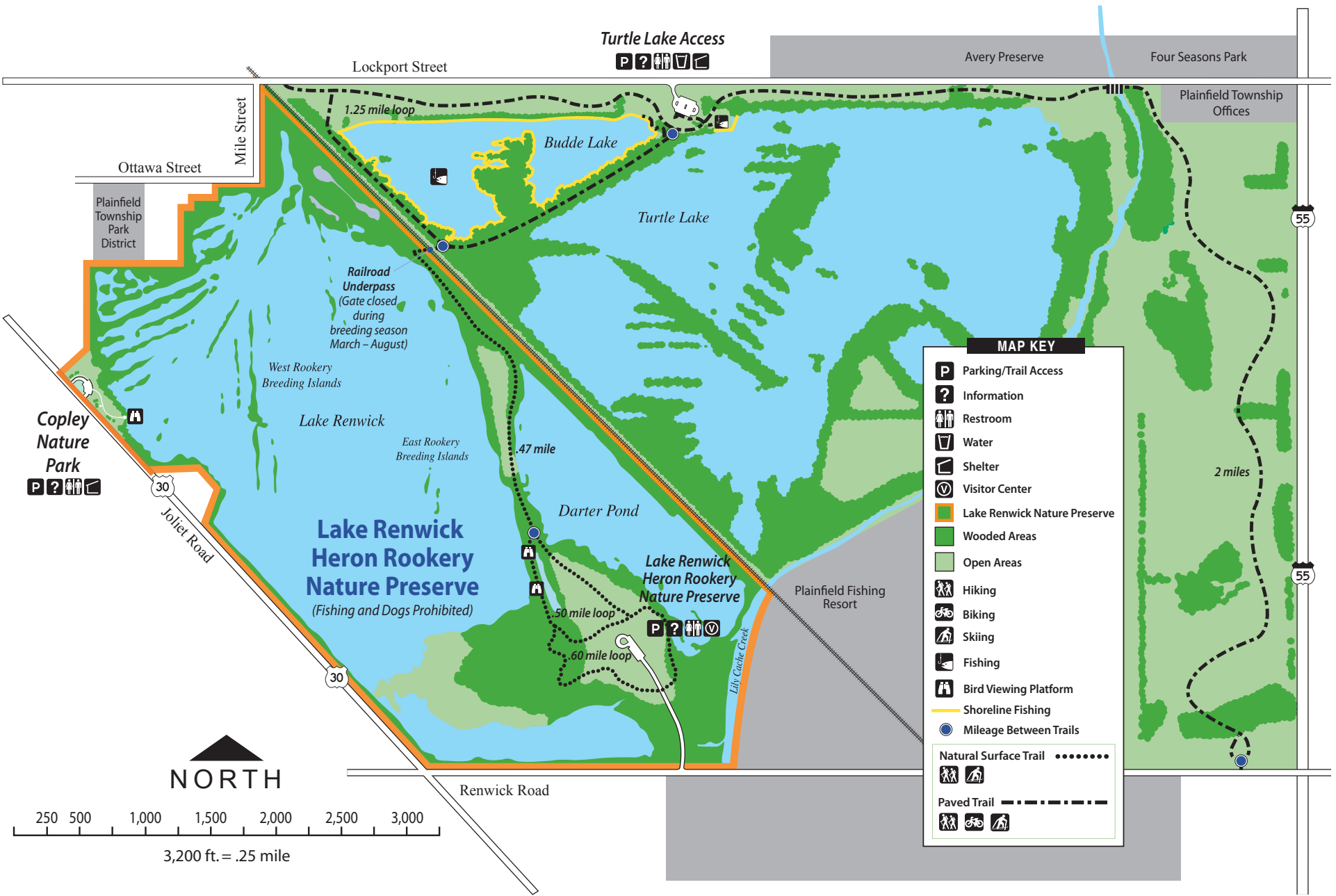


Lake Renwick Preserve

Lake Renwick Heron Rookery is located on Renwick Road, 0.5 mile east of Route 30. Copley Nature Park is located on Route 30, between Renwick Road and Route 59. Turtle Lake Access is located on Lockport Street, 1.0 mile east of Division Street, in Plainfield.

Visiting Lake Renwick Preserve

In 1992, a portion of Lake Renwick Preserve was dedicated as the Lake Renwick Heron Rookery Nature Preserve. The dedication of this site ensures the highest level of protection for the birds that nest here. Nesting birds of the rookery are sensitive to human activities and could abandon their nests if disturbed. Therefore, Lake Renwick Preserve has limited access and activities from season to season.
